Job Purpose	To provide and coordinate medical services for players within the club as well as deliver strong levels of physiotherapy and rehabilitation for individuals. The Club Physiotherapist will work alongside the Sports Scientist to develop and deliver injury prevention strategies, S&C programmes and deliver rehab to injured players. To help maximise player performance, enhance recovery and reduce the likelihood of injuries.
Duties and Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure that all playing staff are offered high quality athletic performance support on a day to day basis. • To keep abreast with sport science research development and advances and maintain an open and flexible stance with regard to best sport science practice. • Oversee and assist in the delivery of best practice strength and conditioning coaching in line with the department philosophies, to all professional players. • Assist in the production and delivery of gym and field-based conditioning programmes tailored for differing needs of each player and specific team units. • Produce and lead end stage rehabilitation sessions with injured players in conjunction with the physiotherapist. • Develop and assist in all physical assessment procedures with all professional players, and ensure all data is recorded and interpreted, with future programmes tailored to individual needs. • Maintain a database of all conditioning conducted with the players, and be able to intervene and readjust programmes. • Collaborate with the physiotherapist to ensure best practice injury prevention methods are conducted including pre-hab sessions. • Monitor individual readiness and recovery strategies and implement subsequent interventions daily. • Monitor and interpret individual and team training data whilst providing knowledgeable feedback to medical department and coaches. • Use training data to try to offer advice on subsequent team training periodization. • Produce individual and team phase reports including readiness, recovery, training and conditioning data. Provide high level of



	<p>interpretation, recommendation and feedback to coaches and medical department.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate a willingness to further personal knowledge into all disciplines of sport science including nutrition, physiology, psychology and biomechanics, by attending relevant educational courses to positively enhance future sport science practice. • Partake and contribute to department in service sessions on a regular basis, aimed at enhancing the knowledge of the department and ensuring best practice. • Contribution to 6-12 weekly player reports providing individual feedback in conjunction with the medical team on players athletic profile and development. • Production of monthly loan reports to any loan clubs highlighting athletic performance data. • Source, recruit, mentor and manage interns to assist with above duties.
