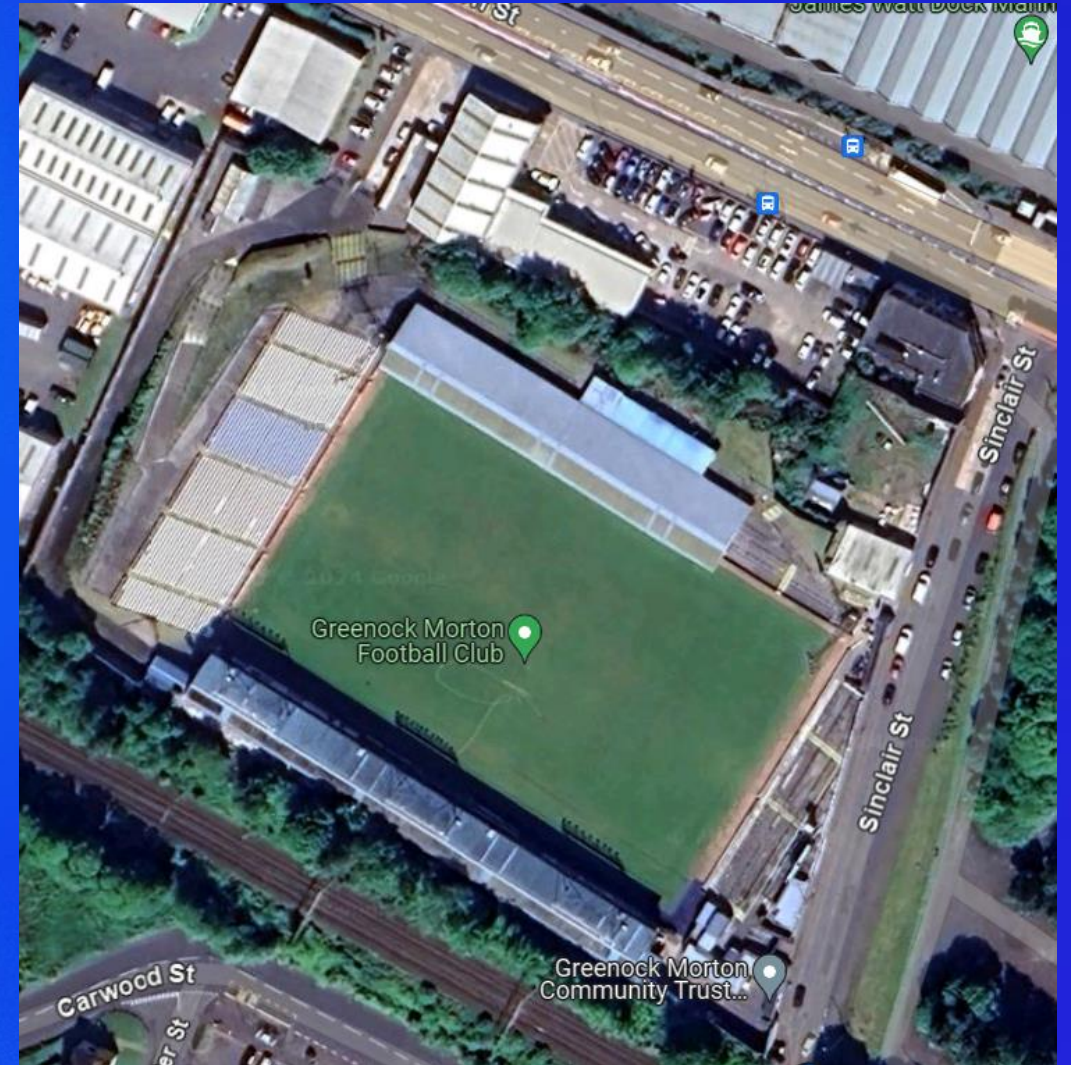
Location of the Ground

Cappielow Park supported by Dalrada Technology is located on Sinclair Street, Greenock, PA15 2TU.

Depending on the demand, sections available to travelling supporters will be sections F&G of the Allan McGraw Main Stand or the Wee Dublin End. Access will either be through the Sinclair Street turnstiles or the Wee Dublin End turnstiles.

Sections within the Main Stand are covered and seating only whilst the Wee Dublin End is uncovered standing with benches available to also sit on.

The Wee Dublin End turnstiles can be accessed at Cappielow Industrial Estate just a short walk along East Hamilton Street.





Walking & Public Transport

Walking

Head East on the seafront adjacent to Rue End Street.

At the roundabout continue East onto Main Street, follow the road until you reach a second roundabout, follow the pavement round onto East Hamilton Street.

Continue heading along East Hamilton Street for approximately 10 minutes until you reach a set of traffic lights at the James Watt Dock Marina.

Cross at the lights to Sinclair Street where Cappielow can then be found on your right. Continue towards the railway bridge where the turnstiles can be found.

By Car

From Greenock Town Centre head West on East Hamilton Street towards Sinclair Street.

By Bus

There are several buses from the Greenock Town Centre, with a frequency of approximately every 5 minutes. Services from Glasgow stop just outside the ground.

And just in case you have to travel from a little further afield, Cappielow Park is only twenty minutes by car from Glasgow Airport!

By Train

From Glasgow Central alight the Gourock bound train service at Carttsyde station.

Not all trains stop at Carttsyde, it is advised that you check the boards at Glasgow Central before boarding.

Exit Carttsyde Station onto Bawhirley Road, walk to the junction of Carwood Street and turn left following the road down the hill until you reach a T-junction, turn left at the T-Junction under the railway bridge, the turnstiles for Cappielow Park are situated here.

Parking

Matchday parking is available in the club car park just across Sinclair Street from the stadium.

Parking is £5 and the entrance can be found just as you turn onto Sinclair Street from East Hamilton Street.

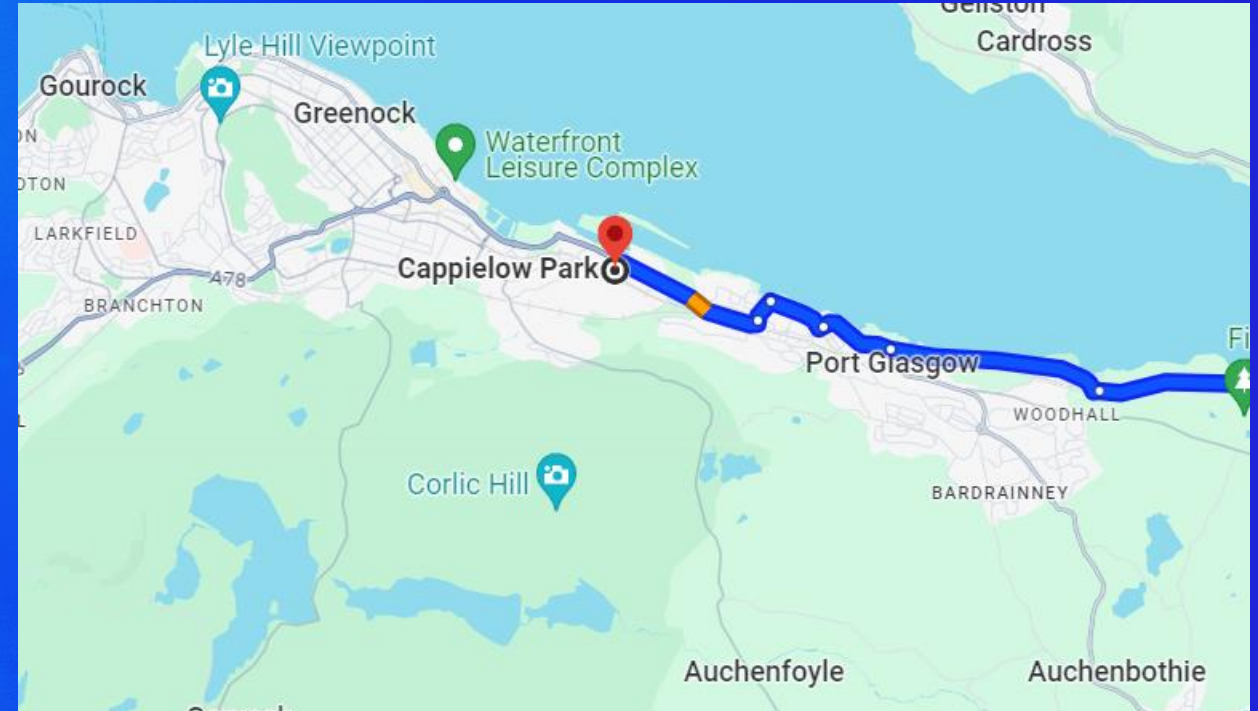


From the North

From the M8 at Langbank follow the A8 into Greenock and the 30mph zone of dual carriageway until you reach the second set of traffic lights, then turn first left onto Sinclair Street.

The Matchday Car Park entrance is directly on your left as you turn the corner. The parking charge on Matchday is £3.00. Please note that Sinclair Street is closed on matchday to vehicular traffic beyond the car park entrance.

Proceed up Sinclair Street and the main entrance to Cappielow Park is on the right-hand side before the railway bridge.



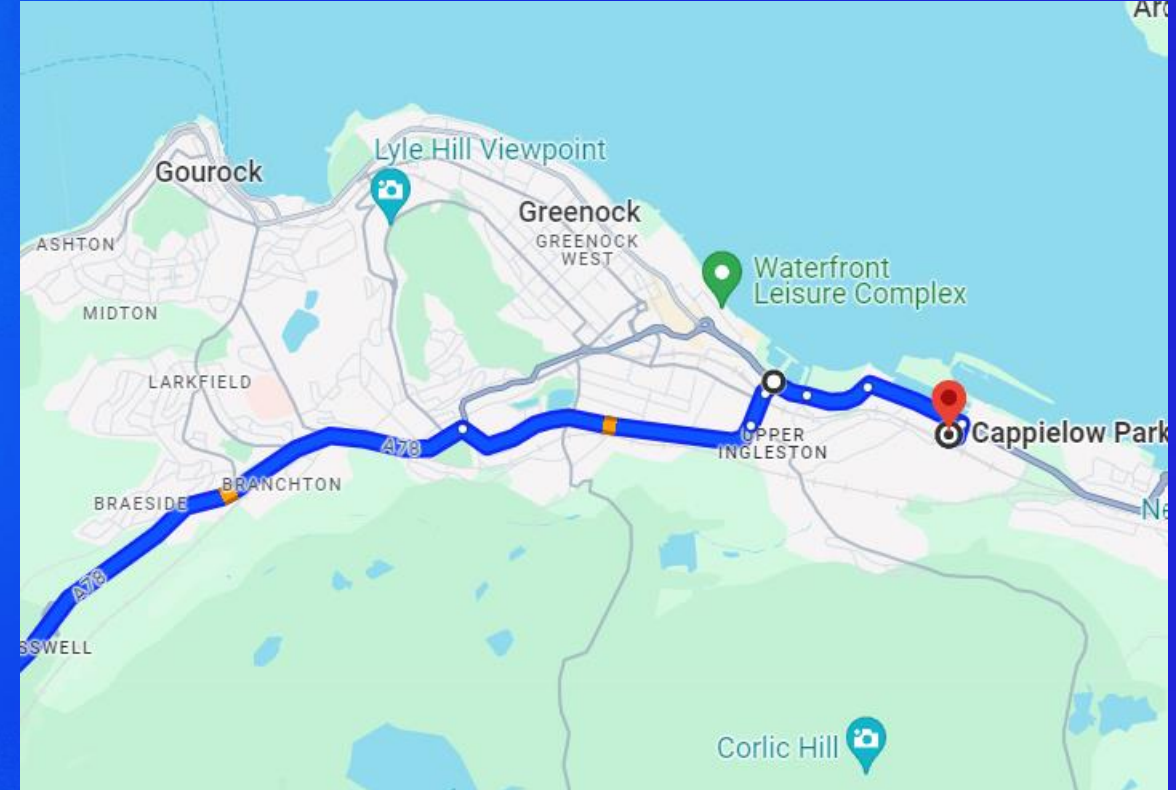


From the South

Head north on the A78 towards Greenock. Follow the road past IBM and continue until the second set of traffic lights. Turn right onto Dunlop Street. Follow this road until it turns sharp left and goes downhill.

Follow the road through the junction until you reach the traffic lights. You should now be facing the river. Turn right.

Follow the main road through two roundabouts and continue until you reach the Cappielow Industrial Estate. Cappielow Park is on the right-hand side of the road.

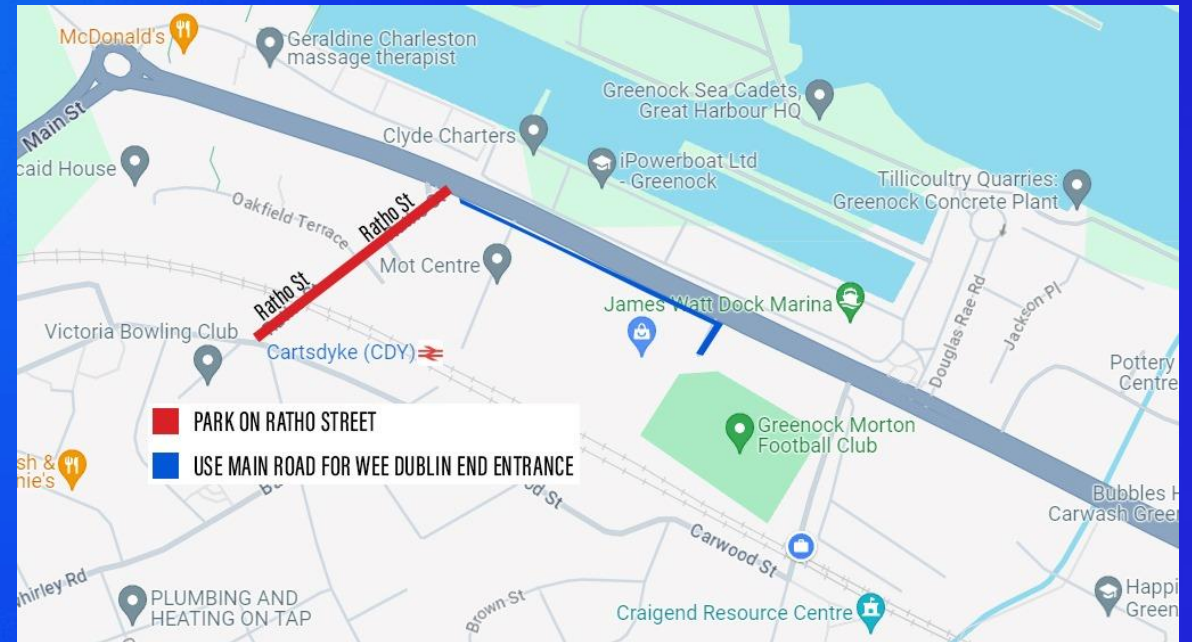




Supporters Coaches & Parking

There is no designated parking available for supporters' coaches at Cappielow, coaches are advised to use Ratho Street to drop fans, just a short walk away from the stadium.

Parking is available in the Sinclair Street car park for supporters travelling by car. There is a matchday parking charge of £3, spaces are subject to availability.





Tickets

Ticketing arrangements for visiting supporters are decided on a game-to-game basis. Ticketing information will be available in advance of the match indicating whether tickets are all online or available at the gate on the day as well.

Tickets are sold through our ticketing partner fanbase. If tickets are made available to away supporters for physical purchasing on matchday, these will be available from the Sinclair Street ticket office next to the main entrance of Cappielow.

Our concessionary rates offered to Greenock Morton senior citizens and junior supporters also apply to supporters of the visiting club. Unless the game has been stated as online ticket sales only, subject to availability tickets can be purchased on the day of the game from the Sinclair Street ticket office. All ticket prices remain the same on the day.

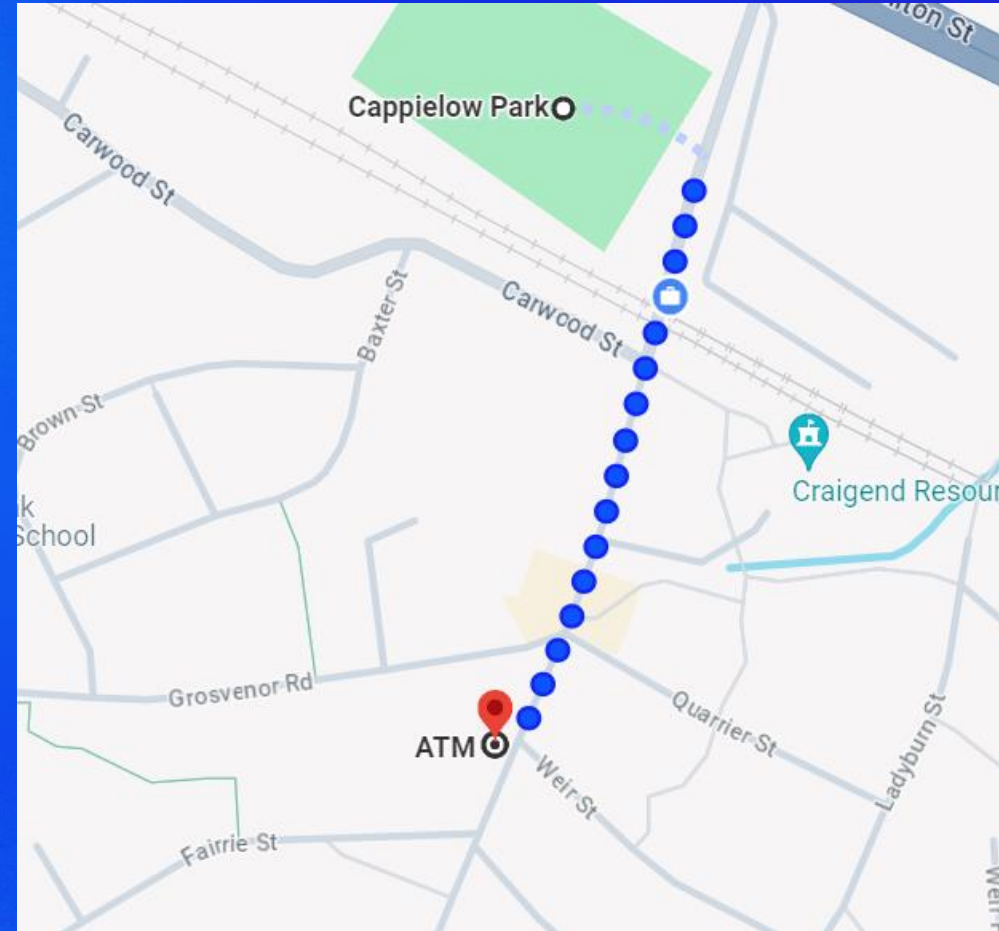
We strongly advise visiting supporters to purchase tickets in advance of arriving at the ground on matchday. QR codes will also be placed outside of the ground that can be scanned to purchase tickets.

Cash Points

The nearest cash point to Cappielow can be found just a short walk up Sinclair Street, approximately a 5-minute walk with free cash withdrawals.





Disabled Supporters

To purchase an ambulant ticket with a complimentary carer ticket, you must contact the Cappielow office at admin@gmfc.net or call 01475 723 571.

Cappielow Park, unfortunately, does not have disabled car parking spaces. General parking is however still available in the Sinclair Street car park just a short journey across the road from the stadium.





Anti-Discrimination

Pyrotechnics

Greenock Morton Football Club operates a zero-tolerance policy toward the carriage and use of pyrotechnic devices.

Supporters should note that anyone found in possession of pyrotechnics will be ejected from the Stadium.





Pitch Incursion

Greenock Morton Football Club operates a zero-tolerance policy toward anyone who chooses to invade the pitch.

Such incursions will be treated with utmost seriousness and will be liable to arrest and criminal proceedings as well as to disciplinary sanctions by the club/event organiser, which may lead to long-term exclusion from the ground.



Smoking

Smoking including all pipes and e-cigarettes is strictly forbidden inside the ground in all areas where smoking is illegal (main stand and covered terracing).

Otherwise, smoking is only permitted in areas where it is expressly identified and in a form (e.g. E-cigarettes) which is expressly stated to be permitted.





Musical Instruments

Musical instruments are permitted on an individual match-by-match basis.

Supporters arriving at the turnstiles on a match day with a musical instrument will be turned away unless they have prior approval.

Instruments must be open and available to search on entry.





Flags & Banners

Flags/banners will be permitted only by request and may be refused upon inspection before or after entry.

Banners and/or other articles that use metal poles, or might be used as a weapon, or cause annoyance or unnecessary obstruction or offence and/or which may cause or contribute to unacceptable conduct are not permitted within the ground.
